FALL REGISTRATION

Since your child is currently registered for a Center Stage program, you have the option to continue to keep that spot in the program for the 2010-11 workshops. This means you won't have to be online at

midnight to get a spot for your child.

Please thoroughly read through the attached paper and send it back to rehearsal with your child.

DRESS REHEARSAL

This Thursday is our first full dress rehearsal. If your child was supposed to bring something from home (shoes, belt, etc.), please be sure they have that for rehearsal on Thursday.

It is preferable that these items be left until the close of the show. However, if it is an item that is needed at home (church shoes, etc.), it can go home as needed. We will also send home stinky socks, undershirts, etc. to be washed as needed.

Also, just a reminder that the kids will be changing in front of one another in the dressing rooms (one for the boys and one for the girls). If your child would like to wear a leotard, camisole, etc. under their costume to make the changing process more comfortable, they are welcome to do so.

HAIR AND MAKE-UP INSTRUCTIONS: Beginning on Saturday, the kids will need to arrive with their hair and make-up done. (The schedule says we'll do hair and make-up on Friday, but due to school being in session, we'll start this on Saturday.) Please follow the directions for your character. Everyone needs to ARRIVE in the makeup and hairstyles noted below.

LITTLE KIDS (Boys and Girls)

Makeup: Foundation (two shades darker than your skin tone), blush, natural lip color lipstick. Girls get a little bit of eyeliner on top and bottom. Boys

get just a bit of eyeliner on the bottom only.

FEMALE TEENS/PRE-TEENS

Makeup: Foundation (one shade darker than your skin tone), blush, lipstick (not too dark). Eyeliner on top and bottom, and a little eyeshadow.

MALE TEENS/PRE-TEENS

Makeup: Foundation (one shade darker than your skin tone), blush, natural lip color lipstick. Just a bit of eyeliner on the bottom only.

HAIR

Girls: If your daughter is a Beauxhomme, she needs to have perfectly straight hair that is not turned under. If she has bangs that hangs down in her eyes, they should be clipped back. If your daughter is not a Beauxhomme, she needs "natural" hair. I don't want bed-head, but it don't want styled hair either. Aim for an air-dried looking hairstyle. If she has naturally frizzy hair, do try to tame that though. ☺ Again, bangs should be clipped back if they hang in their eyes.

Boys – Regular hair-dos, but no hair spray or gel
